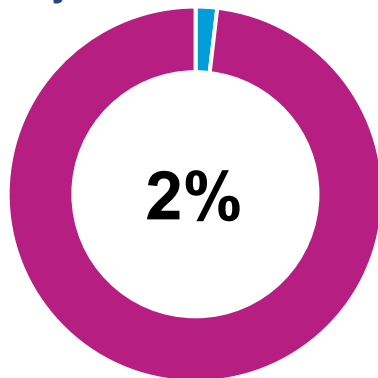

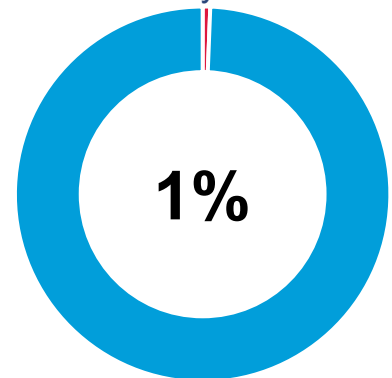
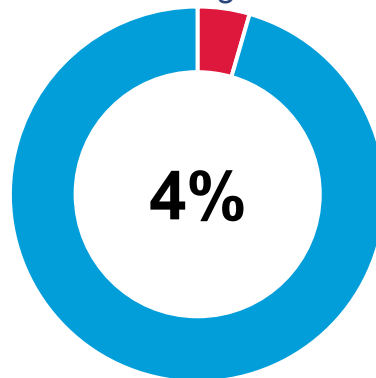

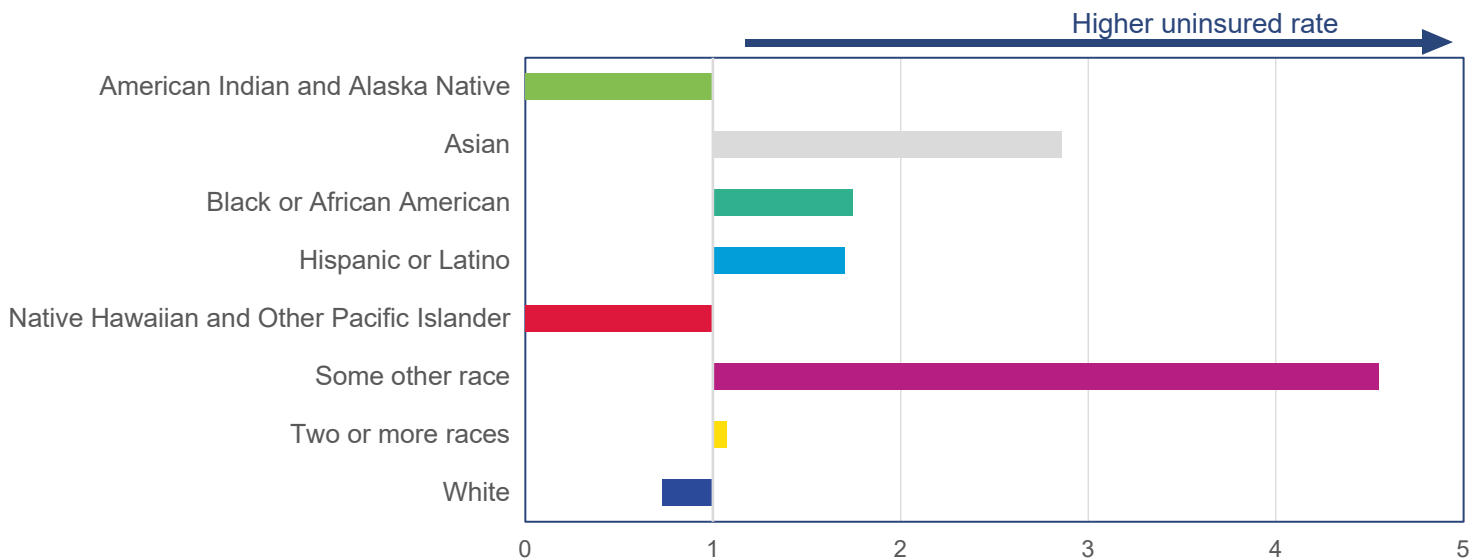
% of all children (under age 19) in the county without health insurance

Children more likely to be uninsured by race/ethnicity

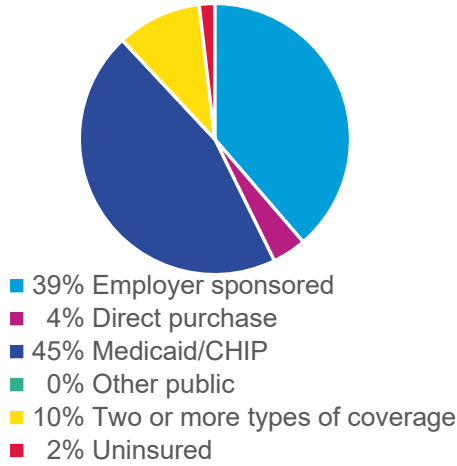

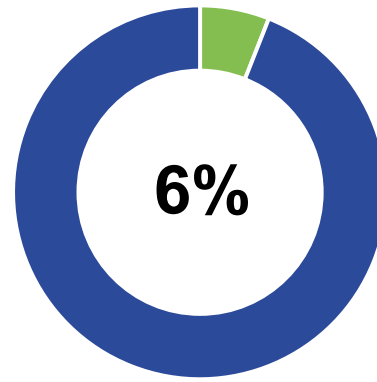

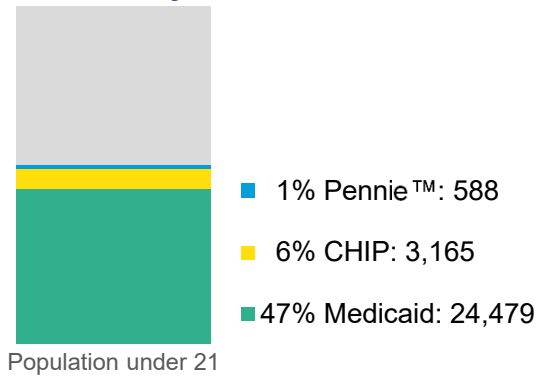


% of county children financially eligible for Medicaid but are uninsured

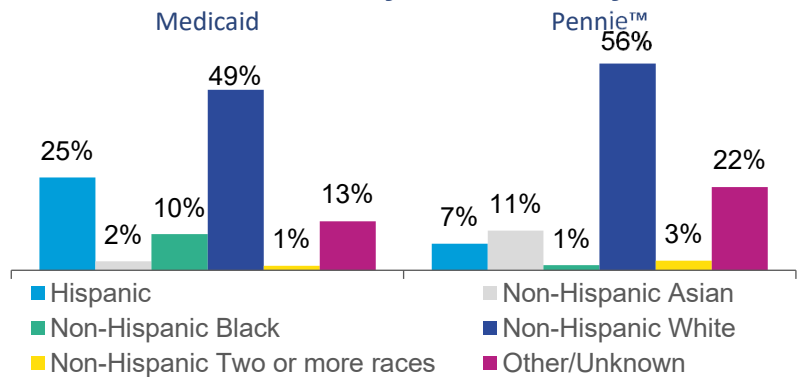


Enrollment in Publicly Funded or Supported Health Insurance (September 2024)

Enrollment by Medicaid/CHIP/Pennie™

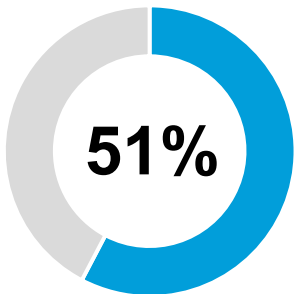


Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

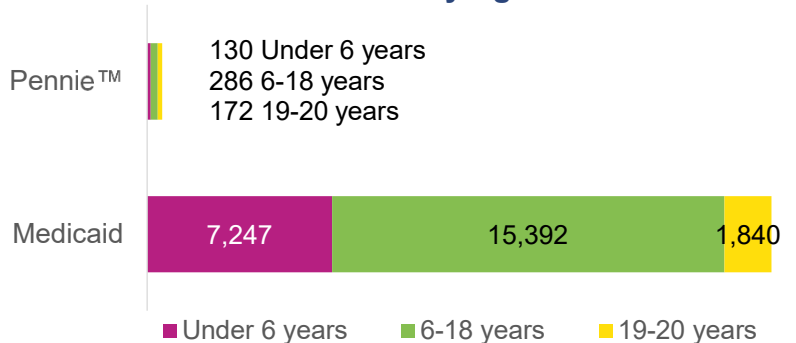
